

Notes

To be awarded a diploma, the student must obtain a minimum mark of 60% in each course with an overall average of 75%. To be awarded an Honours standing diploma, the student must obtain a minimum mark of 60% in each course with an overall average of 90%. Please note that some courses within specific programs require a minimum of 75%, as specified at time of enrollment. CPL status in the Final Mark field indicates that credit for prior learning has been granted on the corresponding course.

To be awarded an "Honours All Subjects" standing diploma, the student must obtain a minimum mark of 90% on all courses within the program of study.

Keyboarding courses reflect the Words Per Minute value achieved rather than a percentage. Results from certain courses reflect a Pass status indicating successful outcome rather than a percentage.

A mark of Complete is issued for certain courses in which no calculated grade is provided but attendance and any other mandatory criteria are met such as in CPR and First Aid courses.

Where a calculated grade is not issued for a practicum, a mark of Pass, Complete, Fail, or Honours is issued instead. A mark of Pass or Complete denotes satisfactory completion of the practicum. A mark of Fail denotes the student did not meet the minimum criteria expected during placement. In some preceptor evaluations, an Honours mark is also possible and denotes above-satisfactory completion of the practicum.
